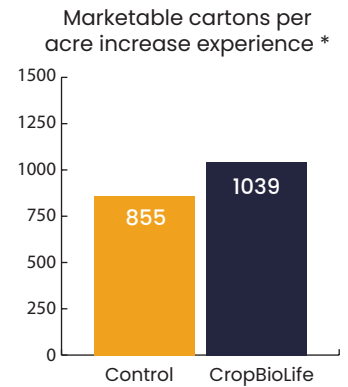
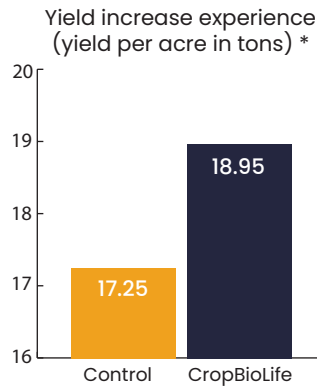

Spray Application

The following table shows the spray rates and timing that should be used to achieve best results.

Timing	Rate (dosage per acre)	Concentration in water (per 100 gallons) based on spray rate of water per acre		
		10 gallons of water / acre	50 gallons of water / acre	100 gallons of water / acre
1st Application – 80 -100% petal drop. The timing of this (first) application is critical to ensure best results.	7 ounces / acre	70 ounces / 100 gallons	35 ounces / 100 gallons	3.5 ounces / 100 gallons
2nd Application – 28 days later				
3rd application – 28 days after 2nd application
